From Richmond:

Take 64 E toward Norfolk/Virginia Beach

Take exit 220 to merge onto VA-33 E/Eltham Rd toward West Point. Continue to follow VA-33 E (19.4 mi)

Turn left onto US-17 N/VA-33 E/George Washington Memorial Hwy. Continue to follow US-17 N/VA-33E (2.2 mi)

Slight right toward US-17 BUS N/VA-33 E/Gloucester Rd (0.2 mi)

Continue straight onto US-17 BUS N/VA-33 E/Gloucester Rd (0.8 mi)

Turn right onto VA-33 E/General Puller Hwy (6.9 mi)

Turn left onto VA-3 W/Grey's Point Rd. Continue to follow VA-3 W (21.8 mi)

Turn left onto VA-201 S/White Chapel Rd. Destination on the right (3.2 mi)

Northern Virginia:

Take 95 S toward Richmond

Take exit 130A to merge onto Plank Rd/State 3E toward Fredericksburg

Continue to follow State 3 E From (2.9 mi)

Take US-17 BUS/VA-2 ramp to Tappahannock/Bowling Green (0.2)

Keep right at the fork, follow signs for US 17 S/Virginia 2 S and merge onto US-17 BUS S/VA-2 Dixon St

Continue to follow US-17 BUS S/VA-2S (5.0 mi)

Turn left onto US-17 S/Mills Dr. Continue to follow US-17 S (40.6)

Turn left onto US-360 E/Oueen St. Continue to follow US-360 E (7.4 mi)

Turn right onto VA-3 E (14.5 mi)

Turn right onto VA-354 S/River Rd (6.3 mi)

Destination on the left
